



FRENCH-BROOKS INTERIORS

Relaunched by Victoria Wormsley as French-Brooks Interiors in 2017 (she bought out Chester Row Interiors from her property development partners), the studio's roster spans anything from an old monastery in the south of France

to a contemporary new build in the capital. 'Our underlying values are that the space is well laid out and lit before we think about decorative schemes. The end result needs to be elegant but also comfortable and individual,' says Victoria. 'I dislike anything too trend driven which will date quickly, or anything so ostentatious that it's intimidating.' Lighting designs are produced in-house so are incorporated from the start, and she loves using textured wallcoverings such as grasscloth to add subtle interest and offset artwork. This season, she is favouring bolder colours such as emerald green and citrus yellow on painted furniture and fabrics, and swapping stone for porcelain in bathrooms. french-brooks.com
