Rare scheme of new family homes in Wandsworth



LOW council tax and a plethora of prep schools, designer shops and trendy restaurants have been drawing families to Wandsworth since the Eighties, while the huge common provides an attractive frame for leafy streets of Victorian and Edwardian houses.

Charles Baker Place, above, is a rare new scheme of nine high-end houses in the Bellevue neighbourhood of pretty, stock-brick cottages and flat-fronted terraces. The chichi shopping parade boasts Michelin-starred restaurant Chez Bruce and Wandsworth Town station has eight trains an hour into Waterloo.
